

JOE ZUCKER – The Good, the Bad and the Ugly

"The Good, the Bad and the Ugly" is a selection of monumental paintings by the American artist Joe Zucker (*1941 Chicago) from the years 1973 until 2007. His first solo show in Berlin offers a subjective view onto the myriad of styles he has explored. This highly diverse and experimental output is unified by a keen formal and historical sensibility and devastating wit.


